



SMART Notebook – Installing at Home

Please note these instructions were written on 11th March 2020 when version 19.1 was the latest version of SMART Notebook, if SMART change their website or release a new version of SMART Notebook your experience may differ slightly from these instructions.


There is a basic version of SMART Notebook that is free to download and use. Many teachers find this very useful to have on their home computers so they can prepare lessons at home.

To download and install SMART Notebook basic version (free) please go to this website:

Click on the link to download SMART Notebook basic version.

You will need to complete the form, we recommend you use your school email address. Unfortunately SMART insist you agree to be contacted via email however you can unsubscribe from these emails.


Choose your operating system (Windows if you are using a PC or Mac if you are using an Apple computer), then click on the Download button. This will download a file called 'smart19-1web.exe', please save this to your computer.



Double click on the 'smart19-1web.exe' to start the installation, you need to be connected to the internet when doing this as additional components are downloaded during installation.


On the first dialogue box of the installer (image to the right) we recommend you tick to accept the terms of use and then click 'Customize' in the bottom left corner of the dialogue, do not click 'Next'.

On the next dialogue box click 'Next' to install the software to the default location.






On the next dialogue box (image to the right) we recommend you un-tick 'SMART Product Drivers' (these are only required if you are connecting your computer to a SMART Interactive Display) and also un-tick 'SMART Ink' as this has often caused compatibility issues (again it's not something you will need at home).




On the next dialogue box (image to the right) we recommend you un-tick 'Start SMART System Menu at logon'.



On the next dialogue box check 'English (United Kingdom)' is included in the 'Selected languages' on the right (as well as English United States). If it's not included select it from the list on the left and click on the arrow pointing right to move it to the 'Selected languages' section.

When you open SMART Notebook you will see a dialogue box like the one to the right.



You will now need to Sign In to be able to use SMART Notebook, to do this click on the 'Sign In' button. You will then be presented with two options, Google or Microsoft. Please click on 'Sign in with Microsoft'. Now enter your school email address and password.



You will now see a further dialogue box like the one shown to the right, its fine to click Accept to this message.

In the next dialogue box enter your Display Name (eg your full name) and click 'Finish'.

You can now open and use SMART Notebook.
